# We Plan to:

Direct all 6<sup>th</sup> grade students in Bel Air, Eastwood, Hanks, and Riverside Learning Communities to the middle schools in August 2022

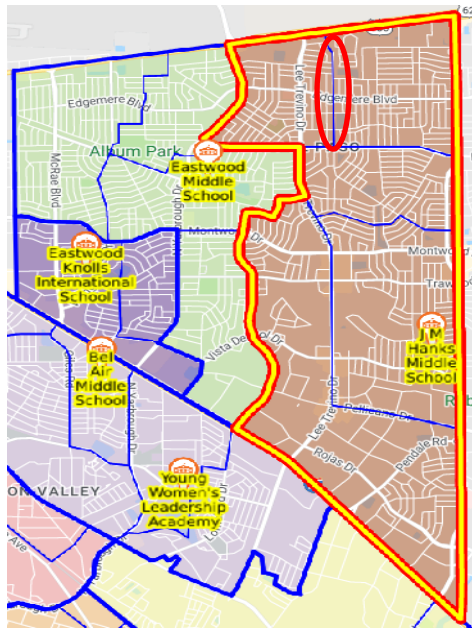
Open half-day, universal PK for 3-year-old students in August 2022

Consolidate Mesa Vista Elementary at Loma Terrace in August 2022

Redirect 79 sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) grade students and 89 seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) grade students from Rio Bravo MS to Ysleta Middle School in August 2022; total 168 students

Young Women's Leadership Academy to the Rio Bravo Campus in August 2023

# Attendance Boundary



Align Hanks Learning Community Boundary so students attending REL Washington transition to Hanks Middle School

Previous western boundary ended at Lee Trevino Drive (red oval)

New western boundary will end at Yarbrough Drive (yellow border)
