Curbside Meals for Pickup during Reimagine Learning

Meals must be picked up from the campus at which the student is enrolled, per National School Lunch Program guidelines. Community feeding (free for all students) ends beginning the first day of school.

Serving time is 7:00 am to 11:30 am, Monday through Friday

For all CEP campuses, parents are required to provide documentation demonstrating the student's name and school ID number when picking up food for their child at the designated campus. The location in which Grab-N-Go services will be distributed will be mutually agreed upon by each school's administration and the Cafeteria Manager. The parent will have the ability to obtain both breakfast and lunch for every enrolled child at the specified campus. These meals will be provided free of charge due to the CEP status of the campus.

Non-CEP campus students will also have the benefit of Grab-N-Go services; however, they will be required to pay for the meals obtained based on their lunch application status. If a student is required to pay reduced or full price for meals, they will be required to have money on their lunch account. If a parent elects to deposit money on their child's account they can do so by providing exact cash or check to the cashier at the school or through myschoolbucks.com.

Child Nutrition Services Procedures

Once the parent or guardian has presented the required documentation to the CN employee, the employee will locate the student's corresponding index card with his/her name, ID number and barcode. The employee will then input the student's name and ID number on a windshield card, similar to the one distributed during Emergency/Summer feeding. Upon receipt of the information, the parent will not be required to provide the documentation on subsequent visits to that campus as long as the decal is visible in the window.

For children with a food allergy or in need of special dietary accommodations, the parent will be asked to pull into a parking spot in a designated area to be provided with a meal that meets the student's dietary restriction. In the event the parent notifies the staff they will be visiting daily, the special meal will be prepared daily, labeled with the child's name, and given to the parent upon arrival.

Please note, as per TDA guidelines, families with children at multiple campuses will be required to pick up student meals at each students enrolled campus daily.
