- Consult with and seek guidance from the on-site psychiatrist as needed. The on-site psychiatrist will periodically review the progress notes of the LPC & LPC-A.
- LPC-A will be required to submit a quarterly progress report provided by the CCC. This document is to be reviewed and signed by Licensed Professional Counselor-Supervisor (LPC-S).

- Must pass a background check
- Current licensure with the Texas State Board of Examiners of Professional Counselors
- Must obtain individual Federal Tax ID / EIN before applying
- LPC-A must have a current LPC-S
