

**SAGELAND MICROSOCIETY ELEMENTARY
DRESS CODE/UNIFORM**

In order to maintain a safe and orderly environment conducive to the attainment of the educational mission of the YISD, all students shall conform to the dress code policy below:

1. **Polo Shirts** - Students will wear a red, white or royal blue polo shirt **with OR without** the school logo every day to school (shirt with a collar). Shirts **must be tucked in** and **a belt must be worn (1st-6th grade only)** at all times.
2. **Pants** - Students will wear navy blue or khaki uniform pants (Docker style, twill), shorts, skirt or skort every day to school. Uniform bottoms may not be worn more than one (1) size too large and must fit in the waist. Additionally, students may not wear spandex or other tight fitting material, cargos, or denim in black, navy blue or khaki material. Shorts, skirts and skorts may not be shorter than two (2) inches above the knee. *Only Docker like professional pants are allowed. *Skinny pants are not allowed.* Shorts are recommended to be worn under skirts and jumpers due to modesty issues with P.E. **Jean pants and Jean Shorts are not part of the uniform.**
3. **Tights** - Only solid red, white, navy blue, or khaki tights or leggings are allowed under skirts / jumpers. Neither patterned tights nor leggings of other colors are permitted.
4. Plain red, royal or white sweatshirts, sweaters or lightweight jackets or sweatshirts may be worn at any time over the school uniform. Jackets and sweatshirts may not be worn more than one (1) size too large. If classroom temperature is uncomfortable jackets may be worn. **Jackets must be unzipped so school shirt is visible.**
5. Club or activity shirts (Band, Orchestra, Fine Arts, etc.) will be considered acceptable uniform shirts.
6. Grades K-6 ARE ENCOURAGED NOT to wear open-toed, open-backed or platform shoes for safety reasons during P.E. **No "HEELIES" will be allowed at school due to safety reasons.**
7. **HOODIES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Students may not wear HOODIES over their uniform shirts.
8. Caps/bandanas/beanies may not be worn while in class or in the building.
9. Every Friday will be considered school Spirit Day. Students may wear school spirit tee shirts with uniform pants or skirts including Girl Scouts, cheerleading and other tops approved by administration.
10. School uniform will be required for field trips and special events. If a field trip falls on a Friday, the full dress uniform must be worn.
11. On special dress days ("free dress"), students must follow all YISD uniform policies as to size, length of clothing. Additionally, students may not wear spandex or other tight fitting material, cargos, or denim overalls. All clothing worn for special dress days must be appropriate for the school environment.
12. Students may not wear makeup to school. Clear nail polish or neutral tones are acceptable.
13. Military style belt buckles and belts with long tails are not allowed.
14. Accessories and/or jewelry may be worn. Earrings must be small. Large dangling earrings are not permitted. Crocheted crosses (prison rosaries) and tattoo style chokers or bracelets are not permitted. Other accessories must be appropriate for the school environment and may not present a health risk or cause undue attention away from studies.
