Student Dress Code

Parents are responsible for ensuring that their child is following the dress code every day.

- Khaki or black slacks, skirts, or shorts (after Spring Break)
- Skirts/Skorts must not be shorter than 4 inches above the knee
- Solid red or black polo shirts (with or without school logo) are acceptable
- All tops and bottoms must be appropriate size for the student. Baggy slacks or shorts or any overly baggy clothing is prohibited.
- T-shirts are not allowed (see exceptions below).
- Wearing hats in the building is not allowed.
- Absolutely No shoes with wheels are allowed. Shoes with lights are acceptable but lights must remain off.
- Leggings in solid black may be worn under shorts, skorts, or skirts, but NOT alone.
- Hoodies with a full zipper and of solid color are allowed.
- Jeans may be worn on Fridays, only if student has perfect attendance Monday-Thursday.

Allowed Exceptions:

Students who have earned the following t-shirts may wear them **on Fridays only**.
