2022-2023 Dress Code

In order to maintain an orderly environment conducive to the attainment of our educational mission, the following dress code which includes the YISD student Dress Code FNCA Local will be strictly enforced.

Jeans/Pants

- Pants/shorts must be worn on the waist. Pant legs no wider than twelve inches. No "baggy" or "sagging" pants are allowed.
- Jeans with cut-outs (openings that expose skin) cannot be higher than 2 inches above the knee.

Top Wear

- Tank Tops with two-inch wide straps at the shoulder are allowed. Anything less than two inches wide is not permitted.
- Spaghetti straps, undershirts, fish net, muscle shirts, **revealing necklines** (**front or back**), bare midriffs, and tube tops are not to be worn **EVEN** if covered by a blouse, jacket or sweater.
- Any male shirt that extends below the bottom of the wrist when arms are extended straight down is to be tucked into pants.

Caps/Headgear

• Caps and Headgear are not to be worn inside the building. Hoodies are allowed; however, you may not wear the hood of the hoodie while on campus.

Belts and Wallets

• Military style web belts, initial belt buckles, chains that secure wallets/billfolds, and belts hanging down excessively are not allowed. Military belts are permitted with the wearing of the R.O.T.C. uniform.

Shorts and Skirts

• No spandex shorts are allowed. Shorts and skirts must be of appropriate length (no shorter than the longest finger while arm is in a relaxed position). This includes skirt slips up the side, middle, back, or front, and openings that expose skin.

Clothing with Advertisement

• Any type of clothing including but not limited to T-shirts that advertise, support, glorify, or display inappropriate language, graphics and/or gestures, gangs, illegal activities, tobacco, sex, alcohol, illegal drugs, violence, death are not allowed.

Jewelry

- Jewelry reflecting gangs, Gothic or Para Military related items including but not limited to rings, bracelets, dog collars, chokers, chokers with spikes (round or pointed) are not allowed.
- Earrings and studs may be worn only in the ear lobes. NO FACIAL PIERCINGS WILL BE ALLOWED.

Shoes

- Steel toes, house shoes, bedroom slippers or boots (only boots with a hard sole are allowed), regular flip-flop, and slides are not allowed.
- Sandals without a heel-strap are not allowed

Other Offenses

Trench Coats and Dusters are not allowed.

Evidence or Membership of Gang Affiliation

• Because such evidence fluctuates, a list of specific apparel not otherwise prohibited by the dress code that is considered by the administration to be evidence of gang affiliation will be held as a violation of "Campus Dress Code".

Extra-Curricular Activities

- The Principal in cooperation with the sponsor, coach, or other person in charge of extracurricular activities, may regulate the dress and grooming of students who participate in the activity.
- Students who violate dress and grooming standards established for such an activity may be removed or excluded from the activity for a period determined by the principal or sponsor, and may be subject to other disciplinary action, as specified in the student code of Conduct.

Violations

- The first time the dress code is violated, the student will be given the opportunity to correct the problem. If not corrected, the student will be assigned SAC(In-School Suspension).
- 2nd Offense constitutes mandatory SAC placement.
- 3rd Offense- Mandatory Parent Conference and additional consequences.
