Graduation

- Five EOC exams are required for graduation:
 - Algebra I
 - Biology
 - English I
 - English II
 - U.S. History
- TEA is not lawfully authorized to waive certain related graduation requirements.
- When students reach their senior year, in order to graduate, they must have either passed STAAR EOC assessments, scored high enough on a substitute assessment (e.g., SAT/ACT), or met the requirements of an individual graduation committee.



Consequences of Missing or Failing the Exam

- Attendance at summer school for EOC remediation and participation in June 2021 test administration.
- Removal of an elective for EOC remediation course in Fall of 2021 and participation in the December 2021 test administration.
- Continued participation in remedial coursework and subsequent test administrations until successful on the assessment.

Safety

- Safety precautions will include:
 - Temperature check
 - Masks required
 - Hand sanitizer stations
 - Socially distanced testing room
 - Water Refill Station
 - Sanitized Restrooms
 - Socially distanced lunch
 - Optional COVID testing with parent permission

April Testing

- *April 6, 2021*
 - English I Exam
 - 5 hours
 - Paper and Online
- *April 8, 2021*
 - English II Exam
 - 5 hours
 - Paper and Online

May Testing

- *May 4, 2021*
 - Algebra I
 - 4 hours
 - Online only
- *May 5, 2021*
 - U.S. History
 - 4 hours
 - Online Only
- *May 6, 2021*
 - Biology
 - 4 hours
 - Online Only

Test Day Procedure

- Check in between 7:30 and 8:30 am
 - Health screening
- Report to assigned location
 - Breakfast will be offered
- Administration begins at 8:30 am
 - English exam will end at approximately 2:30 pm
 - Algebra I, Biology and U.S. History will end at approximately 1:30 pm
 - Students will be provided lunch
- When the test administration is complete
 - Remote access students will be required to leave campus and resume regular online schedule
 - In-person/hybrid students will be required to return to their regular class schedule



Transportation

- If a student needs transportation to school in the morning, the buses will be available.
- Buses will not be available to take students home right after testing is complete.
 - Remote students will need to be picked up as soon as testing is complete.
 - If a student cannot be picked up, they will stay in the gym and continue online learning until the end of the day.
 - They can use the school bus to take them back home after the school day is over.
