DRESS CODE
2018-2019

These are guidelines to help you comply with campus dress code. Our intent is to provide an atmosphere that is focused on student success, not on student clothing. The purpose of having a Logo polo shirt is to ensure all students are identified as Desert View students and all appear unobtrusive and neat. Gang affiliated clothing and/or piercings are not allowed. Our policy follows the Ysleta Independent School District Policy. Both YISD and Desert View policies are enforced. Parents, we appreciate your help in ensuring your child has the appropriate attire to comply with the DVMS Dress Code.

Shirts:

- Polo style shirt – Red, Gray or Black only
- Plain polo style shirts are allowed
- Short or long sleeve
- Red
- Gray
- Black
- Short sleeves may not be rolled up

Undershirts:

- Red
- Gray
- Black
- White
- Solid colors, long or short sleeve
- May be turtleneck or crew neck

Pants (Demin only):

- Jeans & Joggers in dark blue or black denim- only
- Waistband of jeans may not be more than one inch larger than the student's waist (there should be no more than two fingers space at the waistband).
- Pant legs may not be more than four inches when pulled from the knee.
- No shorts allowed as uniform
- Girls may wear jean capris pants.
- Restrictions for jeans and jean shorts:
 - No Super low rise
 - No Cutoffs
 - No oversize or baggy
 - No skorts or skirts
 - No holes, torn/worn out jeans
 - No visible undergarments/underwear
 - No stonewash jeans/light blue jeans allowed, must be dark blue or black
 - No jegging/leggings allowed

Physical Education:

- Tennis shoes required for P.E./Wellness
- **No Vans, Toms or Converse allowed. Must be safe athletic shoes**

Free Dress:

No torn jeans, spaghetti strap shirts, short skirts, shorts or inappropriate graphic tops, jackets or hoodies allowed. Students must wear proper foot attire, no open toe or flip flops allowed. Students not following dress code during "Free Dress" will be asked to phone parents for change of clothes or be send to SAC for the day.

Outer Garments:

- Hoodies that are red, black, gray, or white are allowed. Solid colors only. No full front graphics or lettering are allowed. Uniform polo shirt must be worn under hoddie, ID must be visible and facing forward (showing student picture)
- Wear Your Future Mondays: College and University Pride day shirts may be worn.
- Everyday Spirit shirt day (to include Hanks Spirit shirts or hoodies, no other feeder school shirts are allowed)
- Zip-up, button, crewneck or v-neck sweaters that are red, black, gray, or white are allowed. Absolutely no full front graphics are allowed. Plain red, black or gray polo shirt must be worn under, and ID must be visible.
- Any type of windbreaker or winter coat is allowed. Coats must be worn open when in the building in order for teachers and staff to verify that the student is properly wearing the school uniform
- On very cold days hoodies or jackets that are not school related or have lettering or graphics that promote or glorify sexually suggestive, drugs and/or violence will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day.

Student School ID:

- Student ID (1st one provided by the school) must be worn at all times while in the building, including the cafeteria. If the student loses his/her ID, a new one must be purchased.
- No lanyards allowed- ID must be clipped.
- ID's must be facing forward showing student picture at all times.
- Defacing ID's with marker, stickers or cutting is not allowed. Students will be required to remove stickers, clean ID or purchase a new one.

Makeup/Belt/Jewelry/Shoes:

- No excessive makeup
- Unnatural hair color such as blue, purple, green, pink etc. is not allowed
- Belts are optional. Belts must be black or brown leather type. No studs, spikes, chains or other decorative items. No web belts or military style belts. No initial buckles or large decorative buckles.
- Wrist bands/sweatbands are neither allowed nor excessive bangle, chain, or jelly bracelets. Limit bracelets to two per wrist.
- **Pierced ears only; no other visible body/face piercings to include nose and tongue piercing allowed.**
- Small hoop earrings are acceptable (if a quarter can fit through the hoop, then it is too big). Dangle earrings may not be longer than 2 inches.
- No wallet chains
- Tennis shoes only. No sandals, flip-flops, slippers, slipper boots, Ugg style or mules.
- No backless shoes or heels at allowed.
- No baseball caps/hats are allowed on campus at any time.

Double Dollar Dress Days:

- Approximately once per month. Sponsored by Student Council or PTO
- Fundraiser to support Student Council activities. Benefits all DVMS students.
- Students may wear regular clothes for \$2 on a designated \$\$ Dress Day.
- Clothes must comply with the YISD Dress Code Policy.

Violations of the Dress Code:

- Parent responsible to bring appropriate clothes
- Lunch detention and/or Friday Night School
- SAC (In-School Suspension) and/or Loss of \$\$ Dress Day privileges.
