2017-2018 Dress Code Policy
PLEASE READ THROUGH ALL GUIDELINES CAREFULLY.

Dress Expectations:

All extra-curricular activities, including summer school, where students represent Parkland Middle School require that students be in appropriate attire/dress code. PLEASE NOTE: A separate dress code is enforced for "Free Dress" days.

Belts: Belts are not required. Administration may require your child to wear a belt if he/she consistently sags his/her pants.

- If a belt is worn, it may not have inappropriate language/logos, oversized buckle, decorative studs or spikes.

Jewelry: Students, male & female, may wear one stud earring per ear (1/4" or smaller or small hoops not to exceed 1/2"). Earrings may only be worn in ear lobes.

- NO visible rosaries are allowed.
NO tongue studs or body piercings (other than the ears), "see through" fillers/earrings, gauges, spiked earrings, or dangling earrings are allowed.
NO chains, stud bracelets, choker collars, visible temporary or permanent tattoos, stickers, sparkles or glitter, and face paint are allowed.

Hair: Hair for boys and girls should be clear from the face. Bangs may be worn to the side, but the eyes must be clearly visible at all times.

- NO spiked hair (where hair is 3" or higher on top) is allowed.
NO unnatural hair color (ex: green, pink, purple, orange) is allowed.
NO shaved letters, or designs, bandanas, or doo rags are allowed.

IDs: Students must wear an ID while on campus. Personal lanyards are allowed and may not display gang-related images/messages, inappropriate language or gestures, sexual themes, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, violence or satanic philosophy.

Pants: Must be khaki, black or blue in color. Slacks, cargo or jeans are allowed.

- NO clothing with camouflage patterns is allowed.
NO pants below the natural waistline, sagging, baggy, shredded, ripped, leather, spandex, leggings, sweatpants, skirts, or skorts are allowed. Shorts cannot be shorter than 2" above the knee.

Shirts: Parkland Middle School uniform shirts and pullovers will be sold on campus. Long sleeve t-shirts may be worn under the Parkland logo t-shirt. Parkland Middle School team/organization shirts may be worn every day of the week. For safety reasons, Parkland High School shirts are not allowed.

Shoes: Students are to wear closed-toed shoes only.

- NO open-toed shoes, high heels, steel-toed shoes, flip-flops, sandals, slippers, or slipper boots are allowed.

Earbuds: As a part of the supply list, students are asked to bring a pair of earbuds to use with the technology on campus. These items must be small enough to be folded and placed into the student's pocket. Earbuds must be put away and out of sight when not in use.

- NO over-the-ear headphones are permitted.

Fall/Winter Wear: Parkland Middle School hoodies are sold on campus.

- NO hats or hoods may be worn inside the building.
NO trench coats are allowed.

Administration reserves the right to prohibit any clothing or attire that they deem to be inappropriate on any school day or at any school function.
