DISTRICT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The principals of each high school are the voting members of this committee which is charged with:

- 1. Enforcement of all UIL rules.
- 2. Investigation of eligibility of contestants.
- 3. Settlement of district disputes and questions of eligibility.
- 4. Actions involving other concerns which are deemed necessary and consistent with the rules and regulations of the UIL, the State Board of Education and the laws of the State of Texas.

Other responsibilities are noted in <u>The Constitution and Contest Rules.</u> A person who represents a school involved in a protest or a report may not participate in a decision by the committee (603).

Athletic Directors are non-voting members of the committee and can make recommendations or suggestions regarding rule changes, UIL interpretations and other areas of concern.
