Dear Parents

Thank you for all of your support and efforts in helping your child successfully navigate through this last nine weeks grading period from home. Online learning has its unique challenges and requires a high level of maturity from the student and positive reinforcement from their family. We have seen this across the board with our students. Their success is a testament to the hard work of the students, teachers and family members.

As we approach an important date of May 15<sup>th</sup>, I would like to give you important updates that will affect your child over the next few months.

## Academics:

For grades 9, 10 and 11, the last new assignments for this grading period will be given this week.

\* **For those students who have completed ALL of their assignments for all of their classes**, students will be asked to work on enrichment activities for the week of May 18<sup>th</sup>. They will still be required to check in with their teachers every week until June 5<sup>th</sup>. Each teacher will explain to students this week their process for checking-in. Students are to look at the various lessons that will be posted on our website and in our google classrooms and choose to complete one or two that best interests them. They will share what lessons they have completed with their teacher during their weekly check-in. This will be the only expectation for the week of May 18<sup>th</sup>. Starting the week of May 26<sup>th</sup>, the majority of our students will begin their EPCC virtual summer classes. For the weeks of May 26<sup>th</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup>, while we encourage our students to continue with the enrichment activities, the expectation will be that all of our students prioritize the EPCC summer school classes. During their weekly check-in with our teachers on May 26<sup>th</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup>, students will share with their teachers how EPCC summer school is going for them and any concerns or issues they have so that they can be corrected. Some issues will be handled by our teachers while others will be passed on to VVECHS administrators to resolve. Our goal is to make sure that summer school at EPCC is as trouble free and successful as possible for our student body.

\* **For those students who have NOT completed all of their assignments**, they will continue to work with their teachers to complete their assignments. They will have until May 22<sup>nd</sup> to complete everything. Beginning May 26<sup>th</sup>, they will follow the same rules above regarding enrichment activities and EPCC summer class priorities. As stated above, these students will also need to check in with their teachers during the week of May 26<sup>th</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup> once their spring classes are completed.

## Clearance:

Students will clear the next week on Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. Due to safety protocols, a schedule has been set up with assigned dates and times. It is essential that you follow the attached schedule. If you cannot come at your assigned time, you can come at 3:00 pm on Tuesday or Wednesday, but you must notify us by email of your plans to come at this time. Please DO NOT come at a time that is not scheduled for you as it will prolong the process for everyone. Siblings do not have to come separately...they can come together at one of their assigned times. When you arrive at Valle Verde, please park in the student parking lot. Our security guard will direct you where to park. Three cars at a time, based on the assigned schedule, will be sent up the hill to the student drop-off zone for clearance. At this time, you will simply be returning textbooks. You will keep your iPads for the summer. Fines and fundraising



money will be taken care of during August registration. Our goal is to get students in and out of the drop-off zone in five minutes. When in the drop-off zone, no one is to leave their car. Students will pass the books to one of the administrators through the car window or items may be in the trunk of the vehicle. You must be wearing a face mask at all times.
