


2022-2023 Dress Code Policy

The 2022-2023 school uniform will consist of:

1. Gold, royal blue, or black polo with school logo. We encourage shirts to be tucked in as part of the uniform.
2. Flat-front pants, shorts/skort, skirts, or jumpers in khaki or navy blue. Cargo pants/cargo shorts are not allowed, as well as no oversized or baggy clothes. Plain jeans are allowed, but may not have any embellishments or rips. Shorts/ skorts /skirts /jumpers may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee (wearing leggings does not exclude this rule). Shorts are recommended to be worn under skirts and jumpers due to modesty issues with P.E.
3. The uniform shirt must be visible at all times. The uniform shirt may be worn over a long sleeve shirt, sweatshirt or turtleneck for warmth.
4. Pre-K-5th grade students are encouraged not to wear open-toe, open-back or platform shoes for safety reasons during P.E. "HEELIES", house shoes, and bedroom slippers are not allowed. Steel-toe shoes are not allowed, unless authorized and required for a class.
5. Sweatshirts/sweaters are allowed. No oversized sweatshirts, extra-large jackets or poncho type pull-over jackets will be allowed. Hoodies are only recommended for winter months and for outdoor wear.
6. Jackets worn in the building must be unzipped, unbuttoned, or unbuttoned so that the uniform shirt is visible.
7. Club or activity shirts (Band, Orchestra, Fine Arts, etc...) will be considered acceptable uniform shirts.
8. Keep nails naturally short and clean. No acrylic fingernails, unnatural hair coloring, eye makeup, tattoos, mohawks, spiky hair longer than two inches, or glitter (that in the professional judgment of Administration is a distraction to instruction) will be allowed. No unnatural hair color or sprays, i.e. pink, green, blue, purple, etc.
9. Earrings & studs may be worn only in the earlobes. (Due to safety reasons, loop earrings are not allowed, especially during P.E.)
10. Sunglasses/caps or hats may not be worn in the building, but may be worn for outdoor activities.
11. Free dress Fridays are back. Please reference the Student Conduct-Dress Code Policy.

Clothing should not have:

- abusive or suggestive language/symbols
- chains/long belts hanging from the waist

PLEASE NOTE: A uniform check will be conducted daily. If students come to school and are not dressed according to the school uniform, the parent-guardian will be called to bring the student an appropriate change of clothes. If the parent or guardian cannot be reached or is unable to bring appropriate clothing, the student will be offered clothing from our school clothing bank. If there is a violation, the student shall be given an opportunity to correct the problem. Repeated dress code violations may result in more serious disciplinary action. Appropriate discipline procedures shall be followed in all cases in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.
