What is ROTC?

- Army ROTC is an elective curriculum
- For students who are seeking more than the average college experience
- Designed to teach students how to succeed in any competitive environment through structured military influenced classes and field training.
- Upon graduation you will be a commissioned United States Army Officer with interest areas to specialize in various branches.



Benefits

- Full tuition Scholarships
- Additional allowances (\$600/semester, \$1200/yr) to pay for books and fees
- Monthly Stipend
 - 1st year \$300 per month
 - 2nd year \$350 per month
 - 3rd year \$450 per month
 - 4th year \$500 per month



Scholarship Qualifications

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be between the ages of 17 and 26
- Have a high school GPA of at least 2.50
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Score minimum of 920 on the SAT (math/verbal) or 19 on the ACT (excluding the required writing test scores)
- Meet physical standards
- Agree to accept a commission and serve in the Army on Active Duty or in a Reserve Component (U.S. Army Reserve or Army National Guard)





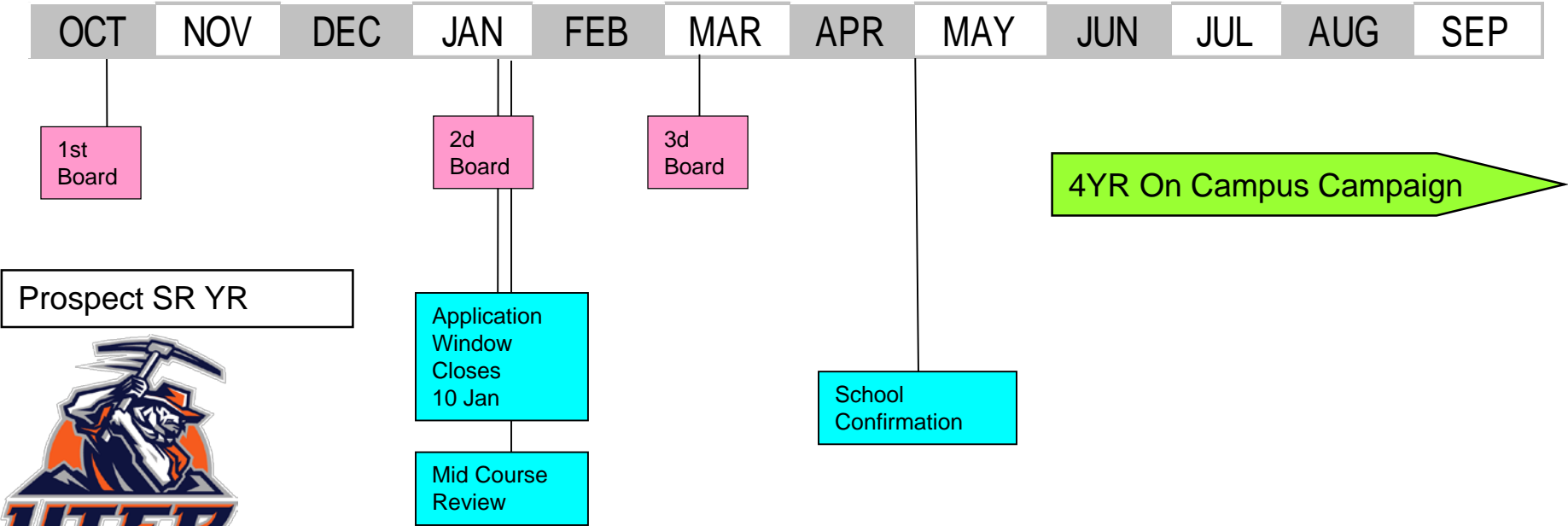
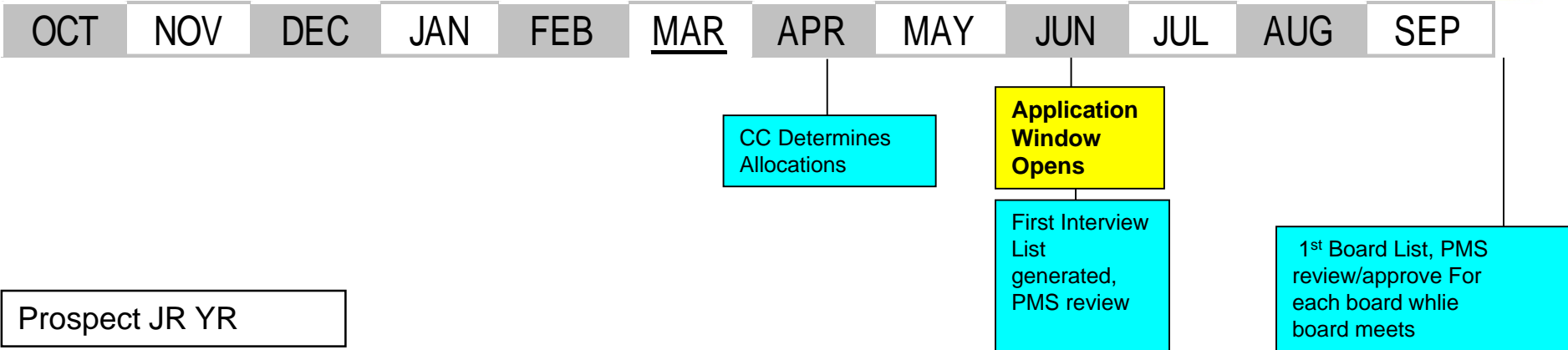
