Artful Science

This camp is a unique and innovative way to teach science through art. It is designed to motivate and encourage students to problem solve and express themselves creatively through reading, writing and art while reinforcing key science concepts.

Jr. Robotics


This camp introduces robotic components and concepts while helping them build and program robots while integrating academics with reading, writing, science and math concepts.

STEM Projects

The STEM camp is a fun and creative way for students to experience hands-on investigations through the integration of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. While finding solutions to real-life situations.



Master Chef

This camp teaches students how to be a Master Chef. They will prepare healthier food options from scratch. It is designed to reinforce good eating habits, kitchen safety and dining etiquette through the integration of reading, writing, math and science skills. Each day will focus on a different lesson and menu, and kids will dine on their own culinary creations.



VEX Robotics

The camp introduces the engineering design process, robotic design, building, and programming concepts. Students will design, build and program a VEX robot while integrating academics with reading, writing, science, technology, engineering and math concepts. They will learn to design, build, drive and program a VEX IQ robot to do specific tasks.



Shutterbugs

This camp will teach students to learn creative control of a camera and other basic equipment. Through their photographs, students will create a visual story by elaborating on their observations. They will use their photographs to tell and write their story.

Literacy STEAM Camps for current Kinder - 5th Grade Students



Selected students are encouraged to attend engaging Intervention Camps that were created to address math, literacy and science concepts. This is a GREAT fun way to sharpen your child's content skills and get them ready for the coming school year. TSI Boot Camp

Students will have the opportunity to become college ready this summer by preparing for and taking the TSI 2.0. This exam allows students to qualify to take dual credit courses and earn free college credit in high school. Students who meet the benchmarks for the math and/or English exam will never have to take developmental courses at any Texas college or university.

Beyond preparing for the TSI exam, students will have time to prepare for their future endeavors by working on college applications, financial aid and other aspects related to college and career readiness.


Special Education ESY Camps
