**Campus Procedure for
Choices Two Should Know Program**

Pursuant to Texas mandate, the Ysleta ISD School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) reviewed the Choices Two Should Know (CTSK) program. A pilot program was conducted at two middle schools with successful results. The SHAC then sent forward to the Superintendent and Board of Trustees the following recommendations:

1. Encourage parental participation by providing an opportunity for parents to review the materials separately and before the students as well as attending the parent assembly.
2. This program to be presented during regular school hours to grades 7-12.
3. The SHAC recommends only the five components be shown to our students (Parent, Abstinence, Abuse, STD, and Violence).
4. Require Campus Administrators to be familiar with the content before being shown to students.
5. Principal, counselor, and/or nurse involvement. (Principal designates a campus contact person).
6. Campus contact person is responsible for securing signed Ysleta ISD parent permission forms.

The Board approved the program as recommended by the SHAC with the addition of including the Campus Educational Instruction Committee. (See the CEIC Information Packet)

Standardized Campus Procedure for the Choices Two Should Know program:

1. Principal will designate a campus person (the Counselor or the Nurse) to coordinate with the Choices Program person.
2. Campus designee will ensure that Ysleta ISD Choices Two Should Know Parent Consent Forms are signed for each student in attendance at the Program class.
3. Campus shall use the telephone notification system (Seahorse Sam) to notify parents of the program review date.
4. The presentation of this program will be through the health classes as directed by the Superintendent.
5. Students who do not have a signed consent form will not attend the Choices Program; an alternate, non-punitive location shall be designated for students who will not participate.
6. Ensure that each CEIC member receives a copy of the enclosed information packet.

The campus designee(s) will present this information to the CEIC.

Packet contents: Campus Procedure, Program Information Powerpoint, CTSK Information sheet, and Standardized CTSK Parent consent form.
