### Campus Procedure for *NO Means NO* and *Risky Trends and Behaviors* Program

This is a sexual assault *awareness* and *prevention* program that addresses two of the four components of Dating Violence Awareness as mandated by state law. This program has an additional lesson called *Risky Trends and Behaviors* that addresses the social, emotional, and legal aspects of sexting. This is NOT a sexual education program as it focuses on the law, however “blunt language” is used.

The SHAC and the Board of Trustees have reviewed this program and respectfully recommends the following:

1. Strongly encourage parental participation and offer parents the opportunity to view the materials.
2. This program is to be taught during regular school hours to grades 9-12.
3. Require Campus Administrators to be familiar with the content before being shown to students.
4. The campus counselor and/or the health teacher will be the contact people for the *NO Means NO* program.
5. Ensure the collection of the District parent permission forms. Provide an alternative location for students not participating.
6. The Center Against Family Violence (CAFV) coordinates the presentation of this program at the campuses.
